

Madison Area Junior Bowling Association Mountain Dew Bowler of the Month Program 2007-2008

Program Guidelines:

*Scores bowled will be based on a THREE game SERIES, most pins over average.

*The cut off date for scores bowled to qualify will be the last DAY of each month.

To qualify for monthly awards in each average classification, junior bowlers must have:

1. bowled a qualifying series as a USBC certified bowler during league play.
2. bowled 3 sessions to establish an average classification.
(Ex: 6 games for 2 game leagues, 9 games for 3 game leagues)
3. their qualifying series based on three certified games; bowlers bowling in a two game certified league may use the last game of the previous week to equal three games.

*A USBC bowler may win only ONCE during the bowling season. The program will run for 5 months from October thru February of each season with the average classifications as follows:

50 and below	51-70	71-90	91-100		
101-120	121-140	141-160	161-180	181 & up	

*A 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place trophy in each of the 9 average classifications for SERIES (most pins over average) will be awarded. Each coach should submit THREE bowler's scores for each average classification for most pins over average along with two bowlers names for the scratch high game.

*A SCRATCH game for each average classification will also be awarded. If a bowler has both most pins over series and high game for one month, please submit a second scratch high game. Bowlers may only win ONE trophy during each bowling season.
